According to the Public Health Department of the Government of Canada, the following initiatives can help individuals reduce the risk of infection or spread of infections by:

- Avoiding close contact with people who are sick;
- Coughing or sneezing into your sleeve and not your hands; and
- Staying home if you are sick to avoid spreading illness to others
